A liaison is a person who can attend specific committee meetings, update and report back to our membership at our monthly meetings. If you are already taking any of these positions in your home school you may want to consider doing it for SEPTA as well. Council Delegates: Two people who will attend monthly PTA council meetings and report back to SEPTA about the happenings with the PTA council. These are night meetings.

Cookbook Committee: Organize a team of people who will collect recipes, submit, organize and help publish and sell SEPTA's first cookbook.

Technology: A position for a computer, internet savvy person. SEPTA is looking to publish and maintain a Facebook page.

Newsletter: Contribute to our SEPTA newsletter, updating members about things that are happening in the SEPTA community. Published 2-3 times a year.

Nutrition: Liaisons for school district Nutrition meetings.
